



Set up file upload from OneDrive via Azure

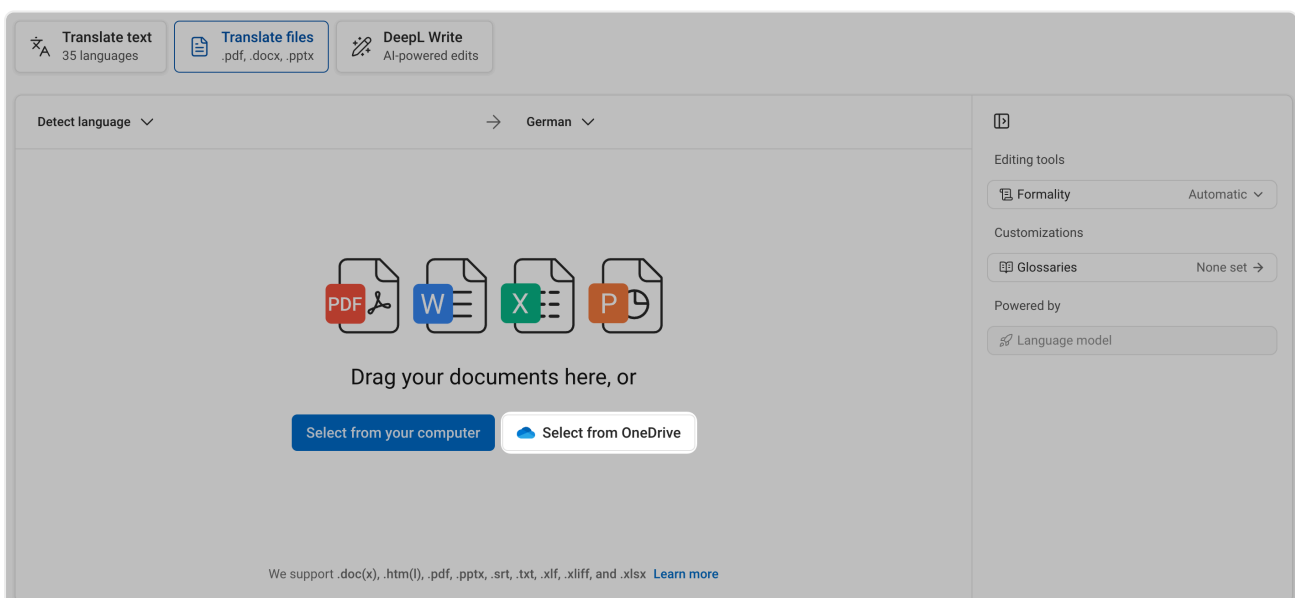


Required: **DeepL Pro**

When selecting files via "Choose from OneDrive", Azure administrators and individual users must grant access permissions.

Without consent from the Azure administrator, individual users will not allow to access the files. First, obtain consent from the Azure administrator.

1) User Access Permissions



An end-user or a Microsoft Azure admin can perform this step.

The first time you click *Select from OneDrive*, the Microsoft account sign-in screen will appear. After signing in, a pop-up will appear asking you to grant DeepL the following permissions:

- **Openid:** Allows users to sign in to the app with their work or school accounts and allows the app to see basic user profile information.
- **Files.Read.All:** Allows the app to read all files the signed-in user can access.

Click *Accept* to continue.

2) Azure Entra ID Configuration

As Microsoft Azure administrator, follow these steps to grant users permissions to use the *Select from OneDrive* option:

1. Access Azure Entra ID
2. Go to *Enterprise Apps*

After a user has followed the steps described under 1), the DeepL Document Translator app will appear under *Enterprise Apps*.

3) Administrator consent

1. Access the *DeepL Document Translator app* and go to *Permissions*
2. Click *Grant administrator consent to DeepL*
3. In the new window click *Accept*

The following access rights need to be given:

- **Files.Read:** Allows the app to read the signed-in user's files.
- **Files.Read.All:** Allows the app to read all files the signed-in user can access.
- **Openid:** Allows users to sign in to the app with their work or school accounts and allows the app to see basic user profile information.
- **AllSites.Read:** Allows the app to read documents and list items in all site collections on behalf of the signed-in user.
- **MyFiles.Read:** Allows the app to read the current user's files.

With the administrator's consent and the user's consent, the approval process has been completed.

4) Select a file using Select from OneDrive

The option Select from OneDrive for file translation will now be available for all users. When selecting the *Select from OneDrive* option for the first time, users will see the permission prompt described under 1).

They can accept the permissions requested and start using the the feature. This process only needs to be followed once, unless a user deletes their browser data or uses a new browser.
